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
Firework Safety

With July 4th just around the corner, our pediatricians want to remind everyone about the importance of firework safety.

PDon't light more than one fuse at a time. Many incidents occur when someone isn't paying attention.

Always supervise children when they are handling any type of flame or flammable.

Soak used fireworks in water before throwing them away to ensure that they are completely extinguished.



Small fireworks and sparklers are typically thought to be kid-friendly, but they can also be dangerous if not handled properly. It's better to be safe than sorry, but if an accident does occur, contact your local emergency department and seek immediate medical attention.
